ROAD CYCLING

Speed and skill will come to the fore on the picturesque Royal Botanic Garden course when our cyclists test themselves against the clock and each other.

Time trial and criterium events will be contested at Invictus Games Sydney 2018 by competitors on bicycles, tandems, recumbents and hand cycles.

Criterium 12.50pm – 6.10pm



SAILING

Sydney Harbour will provide a spectacular backdrop for the Invictus Games debut of sailing.

The Invictus Games Sydney 2018 sailing competition is designed to enable both novice and experienced sailors to participate. Each nation may enter a maximum of two teams per sailing event.

Spectators will be able to view the action from the Sydney Harbour foreshore in the Royal Botanic Garden at Farm Cove with the Harbour Bridge and Sydney Opera House in the background.


Arrive early so you don't miss the action!
